

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HIDEOUT SHAH ALAM BOTANICAL GARDEN WEEKEND GETAWAY


This project is a further development of the previous project, a pavilion, into a Weekend Getaway at National, associated botanical garden. A Weekend Getaway denotes 'A place where one escapes for relaxation, recreation and vacation for a short period of time.'

The Weekend Getaway functions as a habitable architectural spaces to enable the activity associated with living, dining, showering, cooking, storage and such within the built up space of 150 meter square. The relationship between the design and the context is also important in making the Weekend Getaway unique to its landscape and activity.





CONNECT






GROUND FLOOR PLAN 1:150




FRONT ELEVATION 1:150










DESA ECO CENTRE TAMAN DESA RECYCLING CENTRE




ASSIMILATE

The building respects its surroundings by adapting to the shape of the terrain at site, creating little disturbance. The floor plan rises with the terrain's height creating a representative walkway through the building.


The clear division in the building's function connects the building all around, creating the need for the surrounding citizens to practise the need for recycling.




















A-Z JALAN BESAR COMMUNITY LIBRARY





Drawings Site Plan




